A Call to Prayer

We are way past the point of doing it in our own ability. Church programs may be useful, but they will not get the job done. It is time to get on our knees and cry out to God for Him to bring conviction and repentance.

Because only then will there be a harvest of souls. And only then will we find true healing for our land.
